

# WATERFORD WATERWAY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

## VOTING Policy

Voting rights at WWMD annual or special meetings:

1. Eligible Voters. All electors (qualified voters who live in the District, including renters and children over the age of 18, who certify their status on the Voter Certification form) or owners of property located within the District are eligible to vote at annual and special meetings of the District.
2. Property Owners. An owner of property can only vote only once, regardless of how many properties he or she owns as full or part owner. Each part owner of a parcel of property located in the District is entitled to vote, provided that any owner whose name does not appear on the tax roll shall certify his or her status on the District's Voter Certification form. A person who owns property individually and who is also acting as the representative of an entity that is an owner of property within the District (including a corporation, partnership, LLC, trust, foundation or association) may vote on behalf of his or her individual property and may also vote as a representative of the entity owner.
3. Entity Representative. A representative of a property owner that is a corporation, partnership, LLC, trust, foundation, association or other organization (entity owner) shall certify on the District's Voter Certification Form that he or she is duly authorized to vote on behalf of the entity owner. An entity owner shall be entitled to one vote by a single, authorized representative.
4. Valid Identification. The District will accept the following forms of identification:
  - a. Drivers license or Wisconsin state-issued ID card showing current address within District
  - b. Deed or other instrument of title (where tax rolls do not identify the individual as an owner of the property)
